

**Criteria for admission of applicants to full-time bachelor studies

to the Faculty of Management of Comenius University Bratislava  
for AY 2025/2026**

*The criteria for admission of applicants to the Faculty of Management of Comenius University Bratislava are developed in accordance with Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education, as amended, and the Rules of the Admission Procedure at the Comenius University Bratislava (Internal Regulation No. 24/2023 - Full text of Internal Regulation No. 4/2021 Rules of the Admission Procedure at the Comenius University Bratislava, as amended by Supplement No. 1).*

1. The basic condition for admission to the university, which follows from the provisions of Section 56(1) of the Higher Education Act as amended, is the **acquisition of a full secondary or full vocational secondary education** (submission of a matriculation certificate). An applicant who fails to prove fulfilment of the basic conditions for admission at the time of verification of fulfilment of the conditions for admission may be admitted conditionally, provided that he or she is obliged to prove fulfilment of the basic conditions for admission **no later than on the date set for enrolment in the studies**. The right of an applicant who has been admitted conditionally to the study shall be terminated if he or she fails to prove fulfilment of the basic conditions for admission at the latest on the date set for enrolment.

2. A condition for the admission of **foreigners** (including compatriots) who have completed previous studies abroad is the demonstration of the necessary competence in the same way as in the case of Slovak citizens, which follows from the provisions of Section 56(1) of the Higher Education Act, namely the acquisition of a complete secondary or complete secondary vocational education. This applicant shall submit a document of recognition of education - **Decision on recognition of a document of education** in accordance with Act No 422/2015 Coll. on recognition of documents of education and on recognition of professional qualifications and on amendment and supplementation of certain acts, as amended.

### Further admission requirements and admission system

3. Applicants for studies at the Faculty of Management of Comenius University in Bratislava will use the **electronic application form** via the UK Electronic Application Portal (<https://e-prihlaska.uniba.sk/>) or the AIS2 system, from which they will also receive payment instructions. It is not necessary to print the electronic application form.
4. The closing date for applications for full-time undergraduate studies at the Faculty of Management of Comenius University Bratislava for the academic year 2025/2026 is the date indicated in the table General information and basic conditions of admission to the study on the cover page of these criteria.
5. For the academic year 2025/2026, the following study programme in English will be opened:
  - Management (taught in English) - abbreviation Am.Note: Applicants for the study programme Management taught in English must submit a separate application for this study programme.
6. An applicant with specific needs who requires reasonable adjustments and support services for the entrance examination shall send a request for an adaptation of the form of the entrance examination together with the application form to<sup>1</sup>, specifying the required adjustments and support services and attaching the relevant professional documentation.<sup>2</sup> The consent of the person concerned to the processing of the personal data provided in the application form shall form an integral part of the application form of the applicant with special needs.<sup>3</sup>
7. **Only applications that are complete** (including all required attachments and payment of the admission fee) **will be accepted by** the Study Department. If an incomplete application is submitted, the Study Department will ask the applicant by e-mail to complete his/her application. If the applicant fails to do so, his/her application will be considered invalid.
8. The faculty delivers the invitation to the entrance examination to the applicant well in advance of the date of the examination to the e-mail address provided in the application form.
9. The entrance examination for the **Management study programme taught in English** is oral and consists of an English language exam and a motivational interview. The admission test will be conducted by videoconference call before a board (which is considered the subject of the admission test) on the dates announced after the close of the current round of applications for the English-language programme.

The maximum possible total of points that can be obtained in the entrance examination is 100, where the score is the average of the scores of the members of the committee, in the structure of the English language and motivational interview in English.

10. Without the obligation to take an entrance examination, those applicants for study in this study programme accredited and offered by the faculty who:
  - a) in the current school year (if the matriculation exam precedes the entrance exam), or in the previous school year, passed the external part of the matriculation exam in English at a secondary school in Slovakia and achieved a percentile of at least 60. The requirement of the external part of the matriculation examination in a foreign language may be replaced by a B2 level certificate (Cambridge First Certificate, TOEFL 87-109), or
  - b) provide evidence of B2 level certificates (TOEFL, IELTS, CAE, CPE), or
  - c) provide evidence of a grade point average of up to 1.8 in mathematics and English for the whole of their secondary school studies from their end-of-year report cards, or for their final year from their half-year report card (for eight-year grammar schools only for the last four years), provided that they have studied each of these subjects for at least three years at a Slovak or Czech secondary school, or
  - d) have completed 5 years of bilingual secondary education in English, or
  - e) demonstrate an outstanding academic record throughout their secondary school studies (GPA of 3.5 or above), or
  - f) have been at least once in the last three years successful solvers of the regional round or participants in the national round of the Secondary School Olympiad (organised at the national level), for applicants studying at a Slovak or Czech secondary school.
11. The Faculty of Management of Comenius University Bratislava plans to admit 100 applicants to the management study programme in English in the academic year 2025/2026. The number of admitted applicants will be increased by a percentage that corresponds to the average number of unenrolled students for the previous 2 academic years.
12. Candidates who meet the condition in (10) will be offered admission. Candidates will then be ranked in order of the number of points obtained in the entrance examination, with a minimum of 60 points for admission.
13. Admission to the study programme is decided by the Dean on the proposal of the Admissions Committee.
14. In the case of a number of applications lower than the planned number of admissions according to point 11), the Dean may decide to admit applicants without an entrance examination.
15. The decision on the result of the admission procedure will be made in writing within 30 days of verification of the fulfilment of the conditions for admission to the study in accordance with the provisions of Section 58(7) of Act No. 131/2002 Coll. on Higher Education and on Amendments and Additions to Certain Acts, as amended.
16. A candidate who has received a non-admission decision may apply for a review of that decision. The application shall be submitted to the Dean of the Faculty within 8 days from the date of receipt of the non-admission decision on the basis of Section 58(8) of the Higher Education Act. At the same time, on the basis of a written request submitted no later than 8 days from the date of receipt of the dean's decision, the applicant has the right to consult the documentation of his/her admission procedure in the presence of persons authorised by the dean.  
If the dean's designee determines that an error has been made in determining the final score, he or she shall notify the dean of the faculty in writing, who shall take this fact into account when reviewing the decision not to accept the applicant.

17. **Tuition fees for the academic year 2025/2026** must be paid by a one-off bank transfer to the faculty's bank account without undue delay after receipt of the decision on admission to study, but **no later than 2 days before the date set for enrolment**. On the day of enrolment, it is necessary to submit a document confirming the payment of tuition fees to the Study Department of the Faculty of Management of Comenius University Bratislava. If the student fails to submit proof of payment of tuition fees, he/she will not be enrolled in the relevant academic year.

#### **Mandatory attachments to the electronic application form for applicants - citizens of the Slovak Republic**

- a copy of the report cards from each year of secondary school and a copy of the transcript of midterm grades from the final year
- a certified copy of the school leaving certificate (if not yet available at the time, to be handed in retrospectively as soon as it is received)
- in the case of applicants who have studied at a school outside the Slovak Republic, a **Decision on recognition of a document of education** is required = **nostrification of a document of education** (handled by the *Regional Office of School Administration*) - a certified copy of the decision must be delivered to the faculty in paper form
- CV in English
- cover letter in English
- proof of payment of the admission fee

#### **Mandatory attachments to the online application for foreign applicants**

- an apostilled certified copy of your final secondary school diploma/graduation certificate
- certified copy of the **Decision on recognition of the education document = nostrification of the education document** (handled by *the Regional Office of School Administration*), in the case of applicants, who studied at a school outside the Slovak Republic - certified copy of the decision
- a copy of the passport or residence document of the foreigner
- CV in English
- cover letter in English
- proof of payment of the admission fee
